#### Complete the following information:

- \* Identify the area of focus / stream
- \* Name(s) of the presenter(s) as you would like them to appear in the conference program; Title and Affiliation (optional)
- \* Identify format: Concurrent Presentations can be 30, 60 or 90 minutes in length
- \* Key contact information (address, telephone number, e-mail)
- \* Biography of each presenter (50 words)
- \* Abstract suitable for inclusion in the conference program (50 words)
- \* Presentation method details (include audio/video equipment required and room set up preference)

#### In 250 words identify:

- \* Title of Abstract
- \* Educational Objectives
- \* Summary of Content

Presenter(s) may submit multiple abstracts for the conference.

#### All submissions will be evaluated using the following criteria:

- \* Relevance to the conference theme
- \* Clarity and coherence of submission
- \* Contribution of knowledge, expertise or best practices
- \* Relevance and utility to participants
- \* Evidence that submission will encourage interaction among conference participants
